Measurable Goals

All primary students will increase their number sense and fact fluency as evidenced by benchmark performance at the grade level and/or growth of 15 on the spring 2024 assessment in comparison to their starting baseline in the fall of 2023.

Rocket Math

students in 3rd-6th grade will demonstrate a target performance of 18 or greater raw score points on the end of year benchmark assessment or show growth of 20% from their personal baseline score.

Problem solving strategies / critical thinking

60% of K-2 students participating in a schoolwide Title I program will meet or exceed benchmark expectations for the selected grade level subtests in the spring of 2024.

Small group instruction

60% of 3rd-6th grade students participating in a schoolwide Title I program will indicate a grade equivalent growth of .4 or greater in the Spring of 2024 compared to the fall of 2023.
